



The Troop signed up for Webelos-ree, now what??

When is it? Friday October, 19th to Sunday October, 21st.

Where is it? Wildlife Action Center of Georgia in Acworth.

What's the event theme? Our theme is the Olympics. Troops (and Packs) are encouraged to choose a country to represent. Have the Scouts make and bring that country's flag to camp. Have fun with the

theme!

Troops should show up early - Troops are asked to come in Friday night to get set up and ready for the event. There will be a short SPL/Staff meeting that evening followed by a Cracker Barrell. The gate will be open at 5P on Friday, October 19th for Troops and Staff to come in and set up camp.

Where is our teaching site going to be? Your Troop will be assigned a spot to teach. The final arrangements are being worked through now. You will be supplied a map with designated sites in the near future. Please be sure to check in upon arrival for specific instructions.

In addition to our teaching materials, what do we need to bring? All Troops need to have a sign or banner that is readable from 50 yards identifying your Troop and Activity. The Webelos will be provided a map of the area upon check in as well.

Is there power at our teaching site? We cannot guarantee there will be a power source at your site (except for the Engineer activity). If you need power in order to teach your activity please let Bob Brown know ASAP. (bobmb0316@gmail.com).

What is the Open House segment of the program on Saturday all about? There will be time on Saturday afternoon for Webelos Scouts, Webelos Leaders, and any parents to visit the Troops of their choice. During the open house this is your time to show off what your Troop is all about. Remember, you're trying to recruit Webelos to the Troop. We encourage the Troops to plan something during this time. Stand out from the Troops around you.

Where is the Troop camping? Troops are welcome to camp close to their assigned session space OR there will be a general camping area in the field for Boy Scouts. Webelos and Boy Scouts will be separated. The Webelos will be camping in the Pioneer village. Please do not set up camp in that area. Space is limited at WLAC so please plan accordingly. Each Troop must register online. Cost for camping is \$3 per person/ per night. Troops will be camping both Friday and Saturday as the third teaching session is scheduled for Sunday morning.

Will there be food available for purchase? YES! Shane's Rib Shack will be on site with plenty of BBQ and a kid friendly menu. Once that menu is available it will be posted on the website. Be sure to bring extra cash for lunch. There will be no pre-registration for the food this year. It will be bought and paid for on site. Bring cash and your appetite! Shane's has agreed to donate a portion of the proceeds back to the AT District to support Scouting in our area. All Scouts are responsible for their other meals. To limit our foot print we're encouraging all Scouts and Adults to bring their own mess kits. We want to limit the amount of trash the event produces.

Camp Fire Program – There will be a camp fire program Saturday night. All Troops (and Pack) should have a skit prepared. All skits will be reviewed and subject to approval by the camp fire program director the day of the event.
